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POLITICS

- Factional infighting deepens within the clerical elite as the Paydari Front-controlled state TV (IRIB) abruptly censors Chief Negotiator Qalibaf's pre-recorded interview on July 1.
- Supreme Leader Mojtaba Khamenei faces growing pushback over a leaked internal letter indicating deep structural reservations about the Islamabad Agreement's concessions.
- Kayhan newspaper issues a fierce rebuke of the president, claiming his public admissions of severe fuel and budget deficits reveal weakness to foreign adversaries.

ECONOMY

- The U.S. Treasury issues General License X, a broad 60-day authorization permitting Iranian crude oil transactions in U.S. dollars for the first time in decades.
- Severe housing shortages and hyperinflation worsen post-war, leaving millions of working-class families facing skyrocketing urban rental line
- Former National Security Commission chair Falahatpisheh warns that non-military state workers face extreme distress after going eight months without salary disbursements.

FOREIGN AFFAIRS

- High-level American and Iranian diplomatic delegations convene an emergency summit in Doha to negotiate technical disputes regarding transit rules in the Strait.
- Foreign Minister Araghchi extends official gratitude to international delegations arriving in Tehran for state ceremonies despite intense Western diplomatic pressure.
- Nuclear negotiators in Geneva report a structural deadlock over the sequential timing of centrifuge decommissioning versus complete international sanctions removal.

INTERNAL SECURITY

- The state judiciary intensifies its anti-dissident crackdown, executing at least 134 prisoners within a single month and hanging 20 people in a 48-hour span.
- Tehran's Revolutionary Court under Judge Salavati issues a controversial death sentence against political activist Pakshshah Fallahi, drawing immediate domestic outcries.
- Cyber police units deploy heavy digital surveillance sweeps across main market hubs to intercept informal currency exchange dealers bypassing central bank channels.

DEFENCE

- Major General Yahya Rahim Safavi warns that Iran will weaponize both the Strait of Hormuz and Bab al-Mandeb if Washington breaches the signed truce.
- Coordinate-tracking radars and anti-drone defense batteries scale up defensive perimeters around strategic industrial installations near Sirik Island.
- Coordinated underground Resistance Units mount 30 anti-suffocation operations targeting IRGC and Basij operational complexes across 22 major urban centers.

HEALTH

- The Health Ministry partners alongside the Red Crescent to prioritize the logistics and clearing of unblocked Western oncology shipments at Bandar Abbas docks.
- Local clinical networks across Mashhad experience mild supply reliefs for critical pharmaceuticals as early sanctions waivers slowly unravel trade blocks.
- Medical directorates deploy emergency mobile triage units to handle a massive influx of heatstroke casualties driven by record summer heatwaves.
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EDUCATION

- Academic boards at Tehran University complete structural coordination frameworks to launch joint engineering research tracks alongside Venezuelan institutes.
- Higher education monitoring committees impose strict political-ideological vetting filters on student unions prior to the closure of summer terms.
- High school curriculum boards secure ministerial authorization to integrate advanced digital safety and cyber-defense modules into upcoming semesters.

SOCIETY

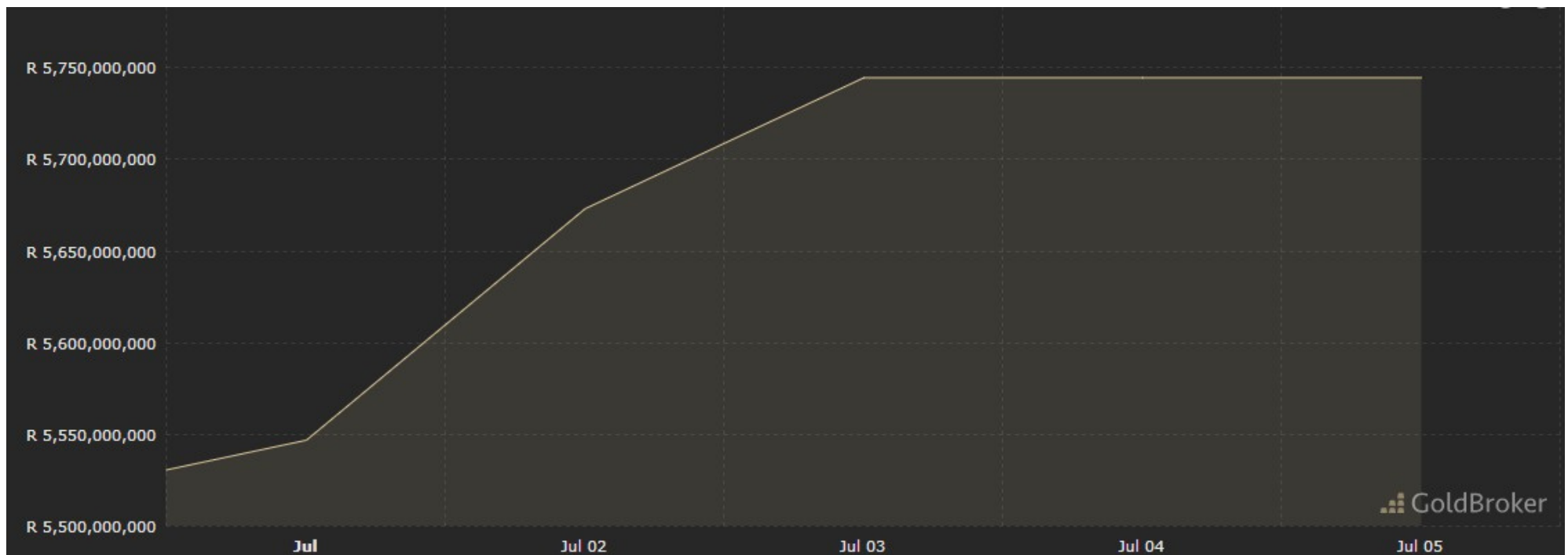
- Millions of mourners gather at Tehran's Imam Khomeini Mosalla for a multi-city state farewell procession honoring the late Leader Ayatollah Ali Khamenei.
- Domestic online forums erupt into highly polarized debates regarding state-backed media using diaspora audio compilations to draw crowds to youth rallies.
- Iran's national football squad exits the 2026 World Cup group stages following a dramatic, highly contested 3-3 draw against its European opponents.

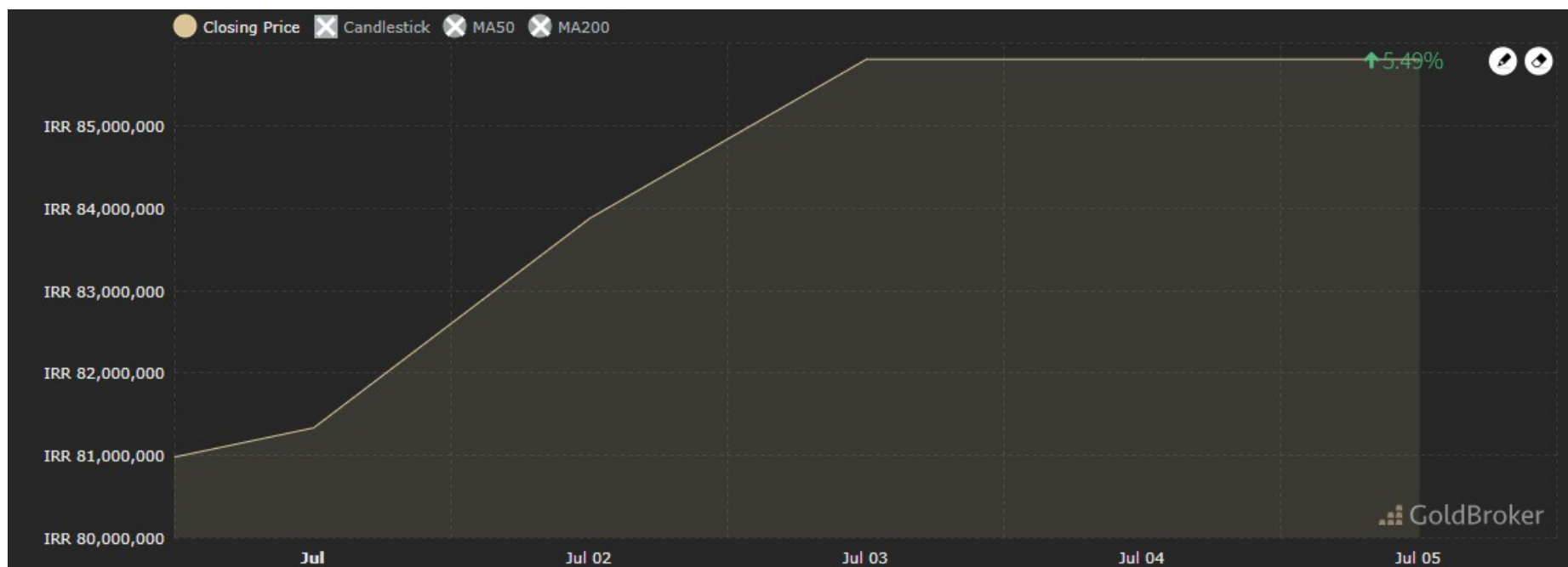

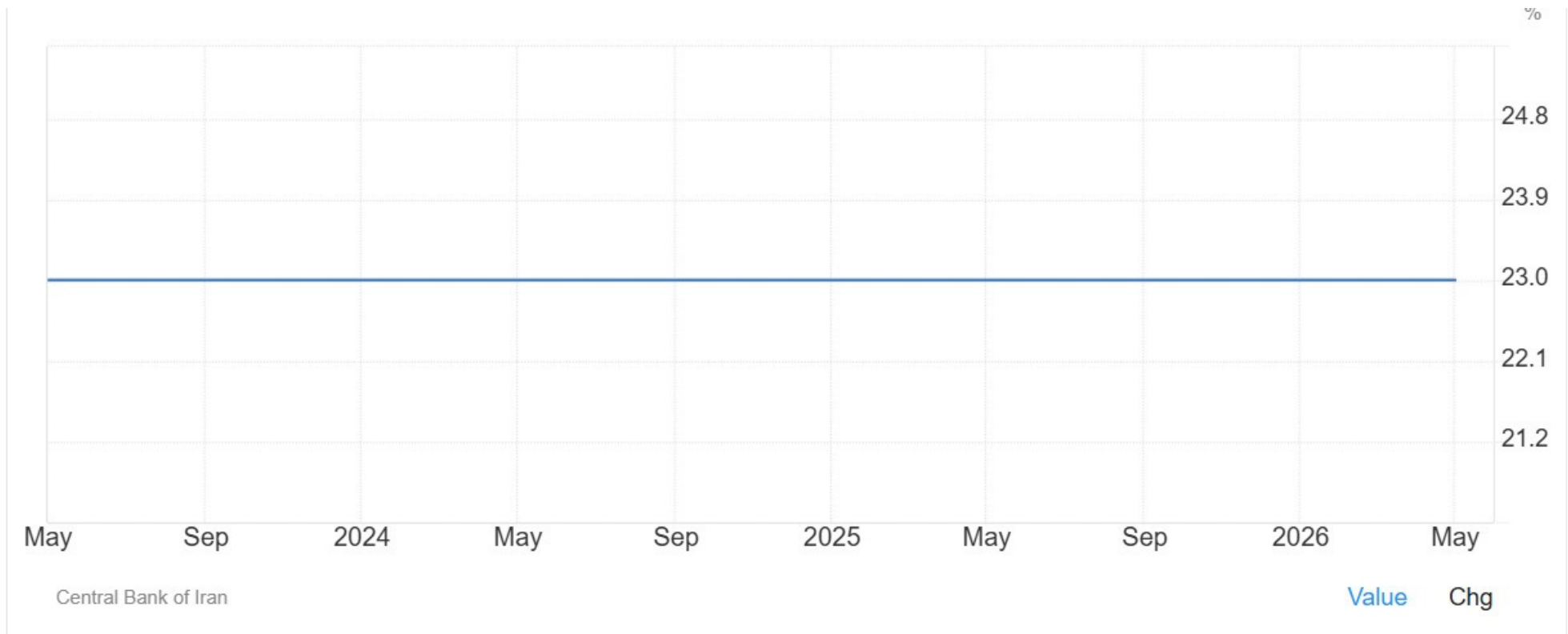
Gold Prices (in Iranian Rial/Ounce)
